Please complete a separate form for each non-legal practitioner who is authorised to operate your statutory deposit account. The Board will only accept instructions in relation to your statutory deposit account from the nominated persons. The nominated persons will be given access to the SDA Transfers service in *LSB Online* which will enable them to lodge transfer requests online.

Please ensure you notify the Board when a person ceases to be authorised to operate your statutory deposit account. You can do this by completing the form, 'Notification of persons no longer authorised to operate SDA'. If you wish to nominate a person who is a legal practitioner, please complete the form entitled 'Authorisation to operate SDA – (legal practitioner)'. These forms are available on the Board and Commissioner website.
