Instrument of Delegation

Legal Profession Uniform Law Application Act 2014 Legal Profession Uniform Law (Victoria)

1. This instrument revokes all previous delegations conferred on the person for the time being holding, acting in or performing the duties of the position of **Resolution Advisor**, by the **Victorian Legal Services Board** (ABN 82 518 945 610) pursuant to section 44(1)(b) of the *Legal Profession Uniform Law Application Act 2014* (Vic) ("the Act").
2. Pursuant to section 44(1)(b) of the Act, the **Victorian Legal Services Board** hereby delegates to the person for the time being holding, acting in or performing the duties of the position of **Resolution Advisor**, its functions, duties and powers hereinafter specified, subject to the conditions specified herein.

Conditions:

1. In accordance with section 42A of the Interpretation of Legislation Act 1984 (Vic), this delegation does not prevent the discharge, exercise or performance by the Board of the functions, duties and powers herein delegated.
2. In any particular case, where at any stage the Board gives notice to the delegate that the Board intends to discharge, exercise or perform its functions, duties and powers herein delegated, the delegate shall not commence to discharge, exercise or perform those functions duties and powers, or shall cease to do so, as the case may be.
